

# Student Progress and Achievement Rate (SPAR)

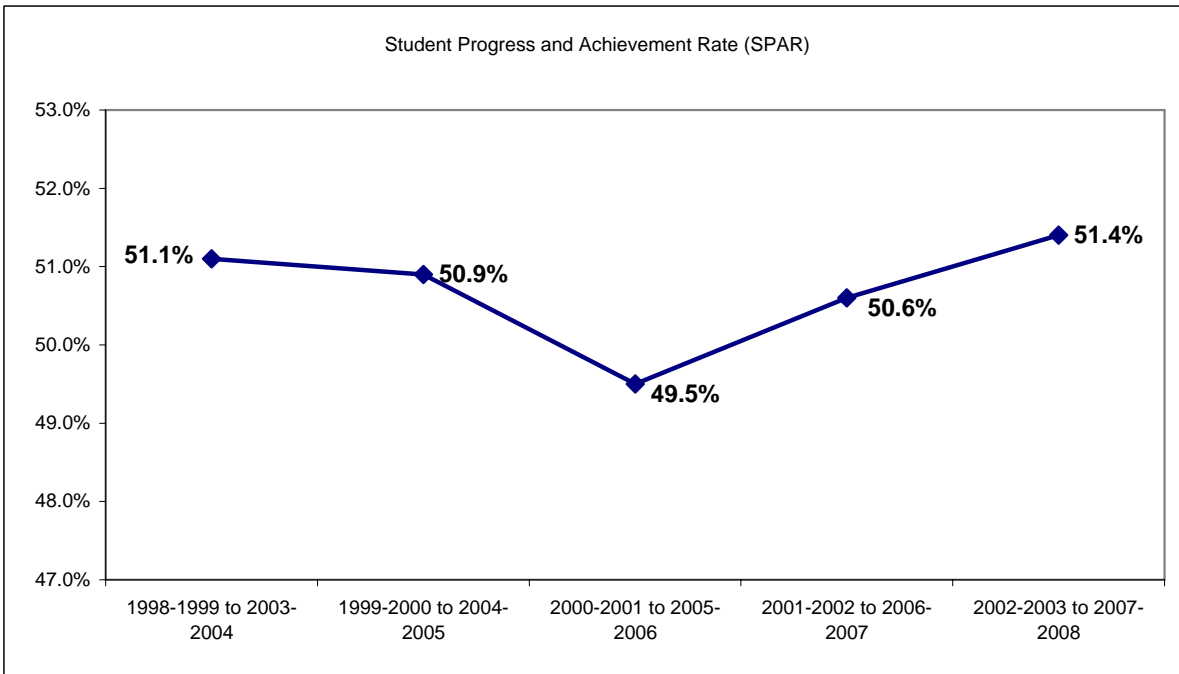
## STUDENT PERFORMANCE

The Accountability Report for Community Colleges provides a system-level profile and trend of overall student progress and achievement. Cohorts of first time freshmen are tracked for six years. Presented below is the percentage of students in those cohorts who transfer to a four year institution, receive a degree or certificate, or acquire sufficient credits to be eligible to transfer within six years.
