

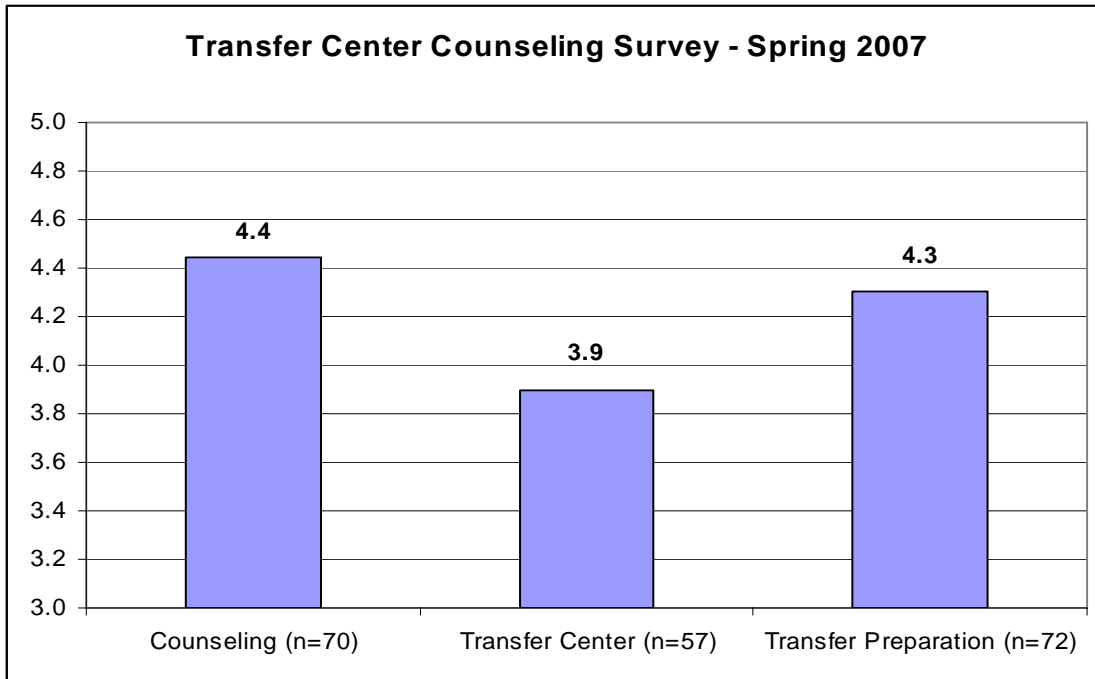
CABRILLO COLLEGE COUNSELING Spring 2007 Transfer Survey

The Counseling Division administered a transfer-related survey to 73 students in the spring of 2007. Students were asked to rate the Helpfulness of the following services/personnel on a scale of **1 to 5**, with 1 being **Not at all Helpful**, and 5 being **Very Helpful**.

Finally, students were asked if they wrote a Transfer Admission Agreement (TAA) for any of the colleges or universities to which they applied.
