

Transfer Breakfast

***Purpose:***

To honor those Cabrillo students who will leave the school at the end of the spring semester by throwing them a breakfast and lauding them for their achievements. After feeding and feting the students, we hope to gain valuable information on how well they feel Cabrillo has prepared them for their transfer institution and how it can better meet the needs of transfer students by asking them to fill out a short survey.

***Why?***

Because so many of our transfer students choose not to get an AA and go to graduation. They slip out of Cabrillo with no recognition of their hard work and often years of effort, not to mention their good grades and the achievement of being accepted by a transfer institution. This breakfast will provide us with the opportunity to recognize them and celebrate all they have done. It also gives the school a chance to find out how we can improve our efforts for transfer students.

***When?***

Sometime in early May, perhaps on a Friday because there are few classes held that day. We do not want the date to interfere with graduation in any way. I would like this to become an annual event, something that occurs every spring, a kick-off to graduation season.

***How Many?***

This semester, 417 students have signed transfer agreements and expect to be leaving . There may be others who have not signed agreements, but may also be transferring. I expect perhaps 150 to attend the breakfast.

***Need:***

I am asking the Student Senate to sponsor the event and contribute \$500 toward it. The approximate budget for the event is:
